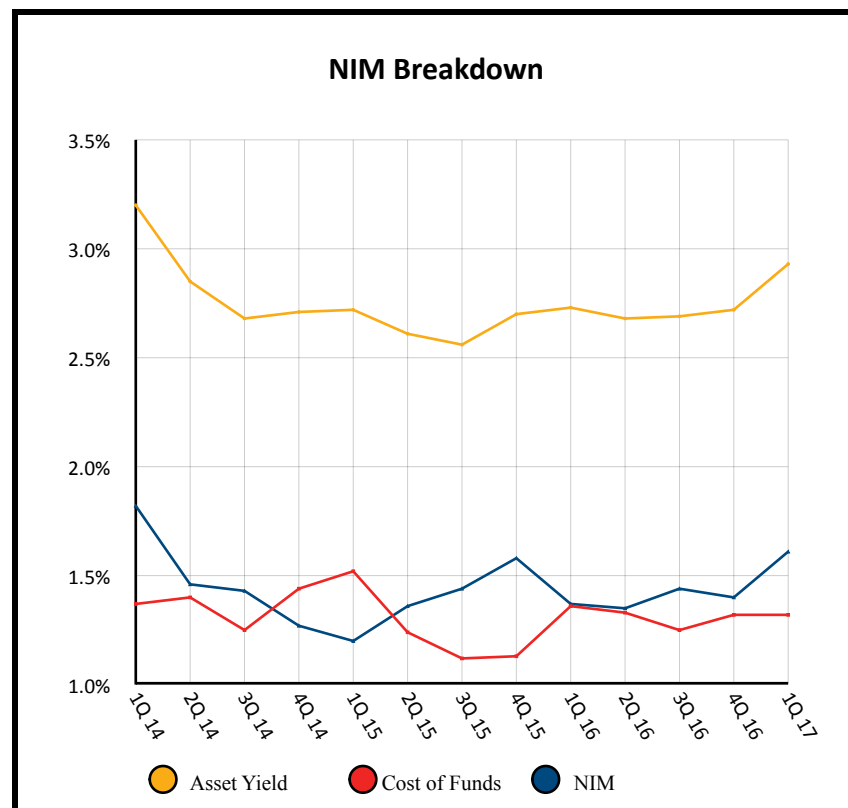

# ARMOUR Overview

## Capitalization

- Total Capitalization of \$1,184.6 million composed of:
  - Estimated book value of common stock of \$988.8 million.
  - Preferred stock par value of \$195.8 million.

## Common Stock Dividend Policy

- ARMOUR pays common stock dividends monthly.
- Dividends are typically announced on a monthly basis.
- Since inception, ARR has paid out \$1.26 billion in dividends through May 2017.<sup>(1)</sup>

## Shareholder Alignment

- \$250 million in share repurchases between May 2013 and December 2015.
- \$123 million additional "return of capital" to shareholders between 2013 and 2015.
- Senior management made open market purchases of \$1.8 million of stock in 2016/17.

- Agency premium amortization is expensed monthly as it occurs.<sup>(2)</sup>
- Hedge positions are marked-to-market daily (GAAP/Tax differences).

## ARMOUR REIT Manager

- ARMOUR REIT is externally managed by ARMOUR Capital Management LP.

# ARMOUR Balance Sheet Metrics

## Equity Allocation

ARMOUR invests in mortgage securities. Current allocation of equity in repo is:

- 53.0% in Agency securities.
- 47.0% in Non-Agency securities.

## Duration

0.41 net balance sheet duration.

- 3.27 gross asset duration.
- (2.86) hedge duration.

## Hedging

\$4.7 billion in hedges (interest rate swaps).

- 58.8% of Agency fixed rate assets hedged.
- 85.2% of Agency fixed rate asset repurchase agreements hedged.

## Liquidity

\$615.4 million in total liquidity.

- \$228.0 million in cash.
- \$387.4 million in unlevered securities.

## Leverage

5.4x estimated shareholder's equity.

- \$6.3 billion in net REPO borrowings.

# ARMOUR Portfolio Strategy and Investment Methodology

Management has a focused and disciplined approach to evaluating assets for inclusion in the ARMOUR portfolio. ARMOUR employs a strong bias toward a ‘buy and hold’ strategy rather than a ‘trading’ strategy. ARMOUR will strategically sell assets when it believes market conditions warrant.

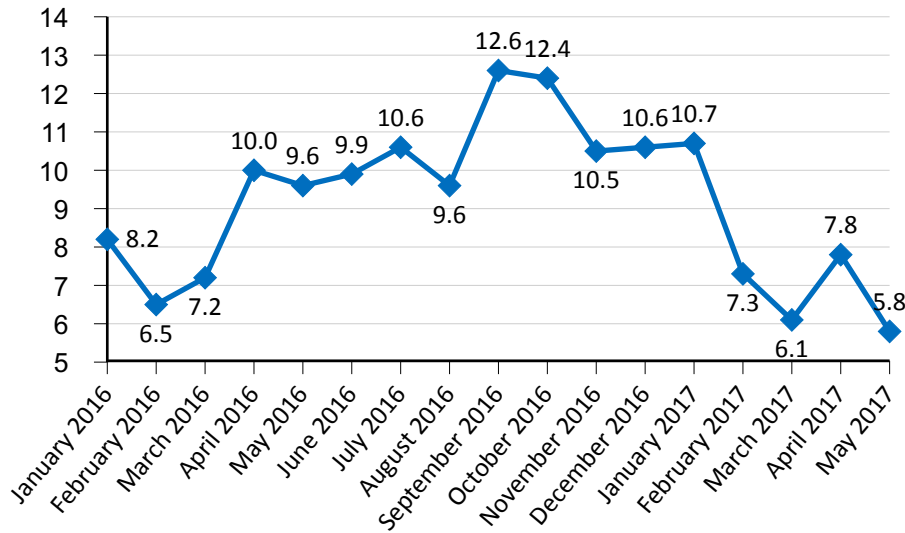

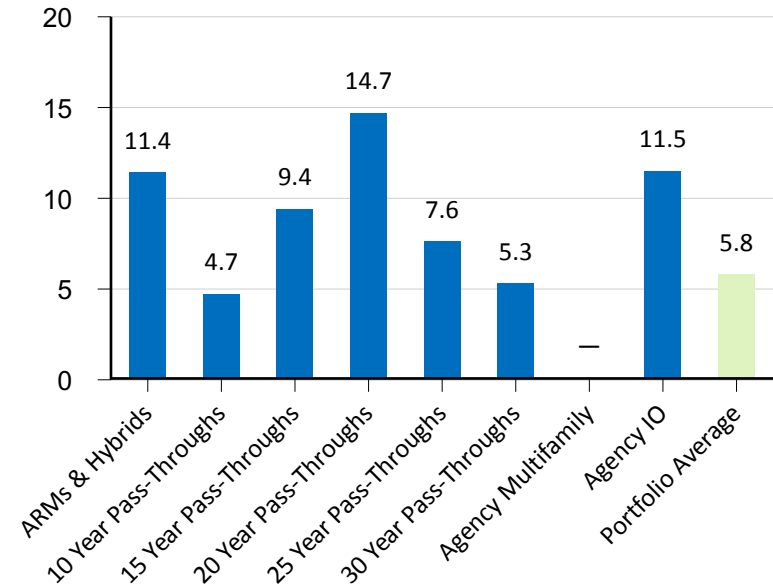
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# ARMOUR Portfolio Constant Prepayment Rates ("CPR")

Constant Prepayment Rate ("CPR") is the annualized equivalent of single monthly mortality ("SMM"). CPR attempts to predict the percentage of principal that will prepay over the next twelve months based on historical principal pay downs.

CPR is reported on the 4th business day of the month for the previous month's prepayment activity.
